

Temporary Rules for Public Participation at Board Meetings During COVID-19 Emergency

For the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic, the GCSEC Central Office will be closed to the public, but anyone wishing to view GCSEC Executive Board meetings via videoconferencing or members of the public without access to sufficient technology to access the meeting may contact the administration in advance of the meeting to request appropriate accommodations.

Anyone who wishes to share a comment with the GCSEC Executive Board during the Audience Participation portion of the meeting can do so by emailing Neil Sanburg, GCSEC Executive Director, at nsanburg@grundyspecial.ed.org in advance of the meeting and the email will be read during Audience Participation. Messages may be left up to one hour prior to the Board Meeting. Only messages left at the specified email address during the specified time will be read, and messages will be limited to three minutes. Please note that GCSEC Policy 2:230 Public Participation at Board Meetings and Petitions to the Board applies to all comments, including identifying oneself. Anonymous messages will not be played. The GCSEC Executive Board President will play as many of these comments as time allows and they will be incorporated into meeting minutes as usual. The Board President may decide to restrict the total time for comments to 30 minutes.
